

Management of Waste Greywater Fee

Motion:

That a rebate of \$200 for instal/operate a waste treatment or greywater diversion or treatment system/device (within the meaning of s68A) – single dwelling be given, if complying with Council Standards.

That a rebate of \$370 for instal/operate a waste treatment or greywater diversion or treatment system/device (within the meaning of s68A) – other development be given, if complying with Council Standards.

Background

This means that the proposed fee for 2009/10 be rebated if the greywater system complies with Council Standards.

Currently not many greywater diversion systems are being installed as they are quite expensive to install properly.

Using rain water for washing and toilets is a much more efficient use than just watering gardens. To then use the greywater from washing machines is the most efficient way of using rain water.

Currently there is no rebate for installing greywater systems.
